

## FIBA Women's EuroBasket 2021

## Qualifiers

November 2019, November 2020 & February 2021

Dear Sir/Madam,

Please find below details regarding the Draw for the Qualifiers to the FIBA Women's EuroBasket 2021 which will be held in Munich on Monday, July 22<sup>nd</sup> 2019.

Thirty-five (35) countries have registered to participate and with France & Spain being awarded as Hosts of the Final Round and therefore automatically qualified, thirty-three (33) countries remain to participate in the Qualifiers.

**Note:** Teams playing in the FIBA Olympic Qualifying Tournaments are NOT automatically qualified for the Final Round of FIBA Women's EuroBasket 2021. All teams except the organiser(s) must play the Qualifiers.

The teams will be drawn into nine (9) groups. Six (6) groups of four (4) teams and three (3) groups of three (3) teams. Each team will play the other teams in its own group in home and away games (Round Robin System).

Games of the Qualifiers will be played in three (3) windows (two games per window) as follows:

1st Window: 10th to 18th November 2019 with the games being played on Thursday, 14th and Sunday, 17th November 2019

2<sup>nd</sup> Window: 8<sup>th</sup> to 16<sup>th</sup> November 2020 with the games being played on Thursday, 12<sup>th</sup> and Sunday, 15<sup>th</sup> November 2020

3<sup>rd</sup> Window: 31<sup>st</sup> January to 8<sup>th</sup> February 2021 with the games being played on Thursday, 4<sup>th</sup> February and Sunday, 7<sup>th</sup>

February 2021

The order of games is as follows:

Game day 1: 1 v 4; 2 v 3; Game day 2: 3 v 1; 4 v 2; Game day 3: 1 v 2; 3 v 4; Game day 4: 4 v 1; 3 v 2; 2 v 4; Game day 5: 1 v 3; Game day 6: 2 v 1; 4 v 3:

Below you will find the seedings for the Draw based on the results of the most recent participation in FIBA Europe Competitions.

The nine (9) Group winners and five (5) best second-placed teams will advance to the Final Round of the FIBA Women's EuroBasket 2021.

To determine the standings within a group, all games will be taken into account.

To determine the five (5) best second-placed teams out of nine (9) groups, the results against the 4<sup>th</sup> placed teams in the groups of four (4) teams will be disregarded to compare the teams on a like-for-like basis.
